1. Science:

The question paper is divided into **three sections**:

- Section A: Biology
- **Section B:** Chemistry
- **Section C:** Physics

2. Social Science:

The question paper is divided into **four sections**:

- Section A: History
- **Section B:** Geography
- Section C: Political Science
- **Section D:** Economics

Students are advised to refer to the **Sample Question Papers** for both Science and Social Science, available on the **CBSE Academic Website**, for guidance.

Important Instructions for Students:

- 1. Divide your answer book into three sections for Science and four sections for Social Science before writing answers.
- 2. Write answers **only within the space allocated for each section**.
- 3. **Do not mix answers** from one section into another.
- 4. If answers are mixed, they will not be evaluated, and no marks will be awarded.
- 5. Such mistakes will **not be accepted** during verification or revaluation after results are declared.

Pre-Board Examination Practice:

Students are advised to **practice dividing their answer books** according to the sections in advance to avoid errors during Board examinations.

Additional Guidance:

As per CBSE guidelines, students should **divide their answer sheets according to the subject requirements** and the space allocated for each section. All instructions provided in the CBSE circular must be followed carefully to ensure clarity and avoid any mistakes during the examinations. Your cooperation in ensuring that students are **well-prepared and disciplined** during the Pre-Board and Board examinations is highly appreciated.
