RULES FOR DEPOSITING THE SCHOOL FEE & MODE OF PAYMENT

- 1. **The fee will be accepted only quarterly.** Deposit your ward's fee as per quarterly schedule to avoid inconvenience.
- 2. The fee counter will be open for depositing the fee through cash/cheque only between 7.35 am to 12.00 noon on all working days for avoiding any late fee charges i.e. Rs.10 per day.
- 3. Cheque should be made in favor of "VIDYA BAL BHAWAN SR. SEC. SCHOOL" for depositing the fee by cheque. If cheque is dishonored by the bank due to any reason, the penalty of Rs 500/- + Rs 10/- per day will be charged as the cheque bounce charges.
- 4. The student's name will be struck off from the school rolls if fee will not be deposited by the last day of the 1st month of every quarter. In this situation re-admission will be allowed with the admission fee at the discretion of the Principal according to the re-admission policy.
- 5. Students enrolled under EWS category need to update their EWS slip as per schedule.

Note:

- 1. To avoid late fee submission deposit the fee before last date.
- 2. Clear your all dues before starting of every examination to avoid any inconvenience on the day of the examination i.e. AC/UT, half yearly, pre-board or Annual examination.

The school gate will be opened for the entry of the students at 7.35 am and closed sharp at 8.00 am. Late entry will not be allowed in any condition. Please do not argue with the security guard or school staff.

The security of the school is not giving the permission for taking lunch box, water bottle or any eatable items during the school hours.

Parents who escort the students for picking & dropping to school, please fix your place outside the school & teach your ward to contact you on the designated place. If you are not available at that place, they will come back inside the school.

Parents, who are dropping & picking their ward from the school either self-escort or through private vehicle, please do not drive on wrong side. This type of practice is encouraging your ward for breaking rules. Please do not drop your ward or park the vehicle in front of the main gate.

Please check & get ready your ward's summer school uniform i.e. length, size, colour, pattern & design of the dress.in advance because without school uniform the students will not be allowed in the school. If any discrepancy, purchase the new uniform for your ward.

It had been observed that some parents have exhibited behaviour that goes against the principles of respect and cooperation. Instances of rudeness towards teachers and school administration staff, particularly during of the time of depositing fee & late arrivals in the morning, we understand that everyone has some personal problems & busy schedule, but it is crucial to approach such matters with patience and a positive mindset.

Maintaining a respectful environment is essential for the overall development and well-being of our students. It is important to instill the values of discipline and courtesy in our children. Our actions as adults significantly influence their perception of acceptable behaviour.

Co-operation from the parents:

- 1. Be mindful of your conduct in front of your ward and other students.
- 2. Demonstrate patience and understanding when addressing concerns with teachers, school administration or school security personnel.
- 3. Encourage your child to follow school rules and maintain proper decorum while wearing school uniform and carrying school bag.
- 4. Provide VEGETARIAN LUNCH in tiffin box of your ward. Non veg., egg and junk food is not allowed in the tiffin box.
- 5. Carry Parents card while visiting the school for any cause. Without parents card, the school security will not allow you to enter the school due to safety of the school students. Please cooperate with the security.
